4 May Thursday

9:00 - 10:00 Savona Zinola Cemetery, War graves memorial site, visit to graves with local and military authorities in attendance;

9:15 - 9:45 Service of prayers and commemoration of the dead at the Transylvania War graves and remembrance wall, Savona Zinola Cemetery. Service in English led by Rev.d Douglas Greenaway (Anglican Church of the Holy Ghost, Genoa);

11:00 - 12:00 off Bergeggi-Capo Noli - deposition of wreath at sea, Italian navy ship present.

Morning 11:00 - 12:00 Punta Predani, Bergeggi - deposition of wreath on the memorial cross to those who died

9:00 - 13:30 Conference on the Transylvania at the Priamar building in Savona
